Overview: For this mini-project you are to use Dreamweaver and Fireworks to create a professional website for a fictitious business in our community. This business may be of any sort that may do well in El Dorado County (Please keep this appropriate for school.) This website is to be something new, and should be relatively different than the type of site you have done previously... for example, if you have previously designed a video game, car, or jewelry site, use a different topic this time. I would like to see that you have worked further with Dreamweaver and have learned something about it.

The website you create must include:

- 1) Fifteen (7) web pages you create (specifically for this project) with Dreamweaver (including an organized directory, and "defined" site).
- 2) Minimum of Ten (10) titles/banners/graphics created with Fireworks.
- 3) All of the pages must all have directive links where necessary (forward, back, etc), as well as a link bar inter-linking all of the pages.
- 4) A minimum of five (5) functioning rollover buttons.
- 5) A minimum of five (5) inserted images (pictures, etc).
- 6) The website must be visually appealing and graphically consistent (similar layout style, colors, and fonts throughout).
- 7) The website must also consistent with the industry standards that you read about the first few weeks of this semester.
- 8) Finally, the website **MUST** include a photo album with a minimum of 9 resizable pictures.
